INTER-HOUSE KHO- KHO Girls Junior

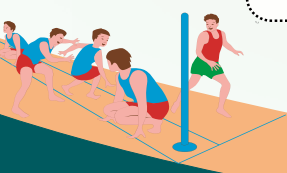
